Construction has begun on new Biodiesel manufacturing plant in Berlin, MD

James Warren, co-owner of Maryland Biodiesel Inc., announced today that construction has begun on the new Biodiesel manufacturing plant his firm will operate in Berlin, Maryland.

The final hurdle, a building permit from county officials, was cleared in late February. Construction began almost immediately thereafter and building is now in progress.

Tanks for Maryland Biodiesel have been ordered from Pacific Biodiesel, a company which has built a total of six biodiesel plants throughout Japan and the U.S. which utilize a variety of feedstocks. Their newest project is a joint venture with Willie Nelson and friends at Carl's Corner, Texas.

With construction underway, completion and ground-breaking should be sometime in June, 2006
